- 2. Complete the "baptismal class" of this church and understand the meaning of baptism.
- 3. Submit a copy of "my salvation testimony" in Chinese or English, between 500 and 1000 words, and email to info@bacfamily.org
- 4. Complete the "membership class" and understand the rights and obligations of being a member.
- 5. Go through a baptismal interview to fulfill the scriptural requirement, with at least two pastoral staff, current elders or deacons/deaconesses.
- 6. Follow Jesus Christ and commit to serving and loving God and others.

About Baptism:

- 1. Baptism is not required to receive God's salvation. (Peter 3:21)
- 2. Those who were baptized as believers before affiliating with an Alliance church do not need to be re-baptized.
- 3. In cases where immersion is impossible due to physical limitations, an alternate mode is acceptable.
